
Poems Just for you

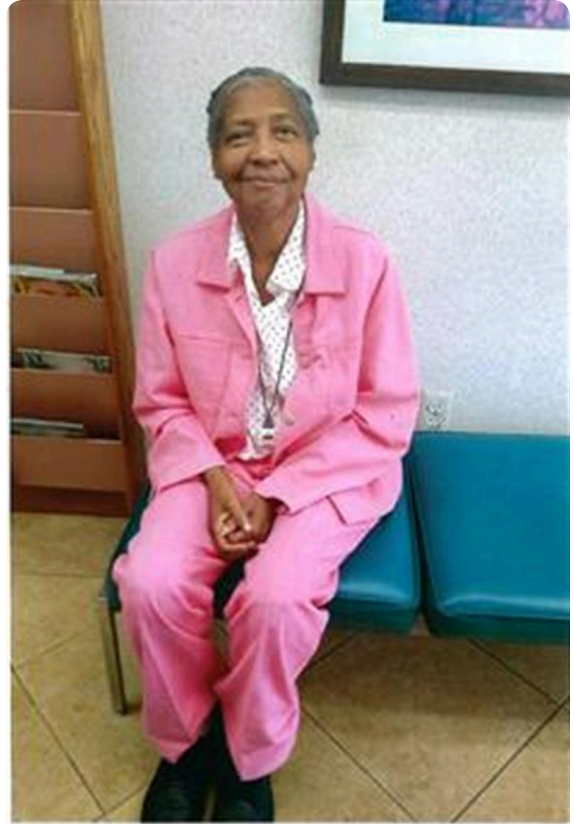
