Lional Campbell was one of the first standouts in the history of the Northwood track and field program. He became just the second Northwood track and field athlete to become an All-American, earning the honor in 1978. He is also one of just three track and field athletes to earn All-America recognition in three separate seasons (1978, 1979, 1980). He still holds Northwood records in the 110 meter hurdles outdoors (13.87) and the 55 meter hurdles indoors (7.27). Both of those records have stood at Northwood since 1980. Campbell was a key part of Northwood's GLIAC Championship team from the outdoor season in 1980. -Jim Knapp, Track Coach at Northwood University
