Nate also participated in private celebrity parties as a bartender. Many bars in the city of Detroit know his name. He was known for being a bartender therapist, and was easy to talk to, especially if you were tipping.

He ran and operated Bottoms Up, Tom's Oyster Bar, Captains, The Zoo Bar, Jimmy's, Mande's, Sweetwater, and Townhouse. He also tended bar at many of the Chene Park events and Wednesday Jazz Nights.

Nate loved his immediate and extended family, and generously hosted many gatherings at his home. He entertained for special occasions of all kinds and the food and drink was plentiful. Nate had a witty sense of humor and a sharp tongue, and had his own way to provide constructive criticism and no-nonsense advice.

To know Nate is to know that his favorite artist is everything Aretha Franklin. She was an inspiration to him and was the one artist whom he could mimic the sound of to the tee.
